### Wed. 1/30 + Thurs. 1/31

Today you will work on your story board. You will draw at least 4 pictures showing the process of each phase. You will also write a description of what is happening in that phase. This must be completed and approved by the teacher before you may proceed to the next step (working on the claymation). Use your notes from Mon. and Tues. or the textbook (unit C pgs. 82-85). This should be completed by Fri. and Mon.

### Fri. 2/1 + Monday 2/4

Today you will start on your claymation if your story board has been approved.

Collect your tray that corresponds to your table #.

There are 4 different colors of dough and a paper plate to make your phases of mitosis on. Be careful to keep the colors separate and not mix them, as other classes will be using these too.

Create your phase on a paper plate, type in the description and take a picture. Do this for at **least** 4 frames for each phase. Try to get 2 phases done today.

# Clean up

Make sure to pick up **every bit of dough** and put it back in the container and put the lid on tightly.

Wipe down all surfaces that got dirty and put the tray back on the table where you found it.
