Below is an example

- 1. (23) Which of the following can be classified as a compound?
- 2. I chose (B) concrete
- 3. The correct answer is (C) Water
- 4. I mixed up the concept of mixture and compound
- 5. I know that water is a compound because it is three atoms bonded together; 2 Hydrogen atoms and 1 oxygen atom. Concrete is a mixture because you can see the individual components and they are physically combined, not chemically combined.
